Rule #3 *and most important.* No one will be allowed in the barn during judging. No exceptions. Those with food entries may stay long enough to make sure that we have them all together, but must leave before the judging begins. This will allow us time to judge all the 2-D, 3-D, and Kidz entries properly & in an unhurried manner and enable us to give our full attention to the performance art in the evening. With any luck, we'll be able to present the awards for all but performance art before sundown, so that the children may go home & adults may enjoy the evening to the fullest.

Clean up for the Art Show is the week before starting Starting Saturday **June 5th, 1999**. Rua has volunteered to feed the workers, so if you give us some of your time, you'll be rewarded with a gastratory delight of some sort or another.

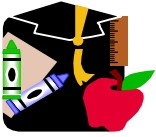
