Other awards will include:

- People's Choice

As well as 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in the 2D, 3D, and Performance categories. Included with in these categories are:

2D: Poetry/Prose, Literature, Painting, Pen & Ink, Photography, etc.

3D: Sculpture, Brewing, Culinary, Functional, Q-mungous, etc.

Performance: Music, Dance, Comedy, Theatrical, etc.

Kidz: Various age categories

Entries will be accepted beginning at 12 noon. There will be a sign in table to fill out information cards and a sign in sheet for each category. Election ballots to vote for the next Guild and the ballot box will also be at this location.

Kidz judging will be at 4:00 pm. All other judging begins at 5:00 pm. No further 2D or 3D entries will be accepted after that.

Performances will begin approximately @ 6:00 pm, followed by the presentation of the 2D and 3D awards.

The judging system that we've been working on for the past few years seems to be running well, so we'll keep it. To give you an idea of how it works, entries are rated on a scale of 1-5 in three categories:

- Originality* - use of imagination, was it an original idea or did it come from a pattern.
- Presentation* - the effort to put it together, degree of difficulty
- Composition* - content
